East Meets West Orchestral Concert is a rare opportunity for audiences to hear traditional and contemporary music from the east and the west, including two immensely acclaimed Chinese classics rarely performed live on Australian stages, *Butterfly Lovers Violin Concerto* and *Yellow River Piano Concerto*.

Popular Sydney music maestro **Guy Noble** will conduct the Canberra, Adelaide and Sydney concerts. Brisbane-born **Dane Lam**, Principal Conductor for Xi'an Symphony Orchestra and Opera Queensland's resident conductor, will connect the Brisbane performance.

Guest artists include award winning pianist **Tony Lee**, violinist **Sun Yi**, Sydney Symphony Orchestra's Associate Concertmaster, leading guzheng player **Angie Liu**, multi award winning Opera Australia soprano **Sharon Zhai** and one of Australia's brightest young mezzo sopranos **Victoria Lambourn**, Brisbane-born who lives in Victoria. The artists will be joined by **Adelaide Symphony Orchestra, Queensland Symphony Orchestra** and A 50-piece orchestra (musicians from local leading symphony orchestras).

The concerts are an **Image China cultural & arts event** organised by **China Arts and Entertainment Group Ltd (CAEG)** presented by **Ausfeng** and the **Oz-Sino Association for Advancement of Culture & Arts**. They aim to introduce traditional and contemporary Chinese performing arts to audiences around the world. Since its inception in 2009 **Ausfeng** has presented numerous inspirational works at venues across the globe.

《中华风韵交响音乐会》将着力从多维度、多层次呈现中西合璧、东西相汇、美美与共的跨文化融合之美。此次交响乐音乐会是一个难得的机会，让观众听到来自东方和西方的传统和现代音乐，包括两部备受赞誉的中国经典作品，即《梁祝》小提琴协奏曲和《黄河》钢琴协奏曲，这在澳大利亚舞台上，进行现场演出，实属罕见。

音乐会将由中国著名指挥家兼音乐教育家**张国勇**教授担任艺术总监，纵横驰骋澳大利亚古典音乐界数十载的著名指挥家**诺布尔（Guy Noble）**执棒指挥堪培拉、阿德雷德和悉尼的音乐会。出生于布里斯班的**Dane Lam**是西安交响乐团的首席指挥和昆士兰歌剧院的常驻指挥，他将出任布里斯班音乐会的指挥。音乐会还力邀来自悉尼交响乐团、阿德莱德交响乐团、昆士兰交响乐团的澳大利亚主流顶尖音乐家与知名华裔演奏家强强联袂。在演出整容上，曾荣膺“最佳澳大利亚钢琴家”殊荣的澳大利亚华裔青年钢琴演奏家**李东奕**、悉尼交响乐团副首席、华裔小提琴家**孙毅**、签约澳大利亚歌剧团的旅澳华裔女高音歌唱家**翟慧娟**、澳大利亚女中音歌唱家**兰伯恩**、青年古筝演奏家**刘茜**及阿德莱德当地知名古筝演奏名师**梁照虹**也将重磅加盟。

作为疫情爆发二年来，首个在澳重磅推出的主打中华经典旋律、中西合璧的交响音乐会，久违的美好弦音和熟悉的经典旋律将为广大澳洲华人开启后疫情时期一次不可错过的音乐盛典，点燃城市对中国文艺的新生与共鸣，着实令人期待。
